## BDA-3.14 Streamer / DAC

### Startup Volume Notice

Your new BDA3.14 can be used with a preamplifier or it can drive an amplifier directly. Set it up based on which scenario you have in your system.

Out of the box, the default volume level is -60dB. This is set so you don't accidentally damage your loudspeakers when connecting the BDA-3.14 directly to an amplifier. If you are using the BDA3.14 with a traditional analog preamplifier, you should set the default turn on volume to 0dB using the following steps:

1. Connect your BDA3.14 to the network using the ETHERNET jack on the back panel.
2. Use your web browser to visit <http://my.bryston.com>
3. Click on the entry that corresponds to your BDA-3.14
4. Look towards the bottom of the page. Click on Audio Devices under Settings.
5. Change the default startup volume to 0dB for use with an analog preamp, or any other desired value when using the BDA3.14 without a preamplifier.

**Remember that just like a preamplifier, the BDA3.14 is capable of driving many amplifiers well beyond their rated power! Be judicious with startup volume.**
